- **Churchwarden** – Following 6 years of faithful service as Churchwarden, Keith Towers has to step down from this important role. Please prayerfully consider who his successor might be. If you have any names to suggest, please do not speak to the person directly, but to Kathryn. (It can put someone in a difficult position by approaching them directly). To help in your thoughts and prayers, please pick up a copy of the Role Description form the back of church.

- **Support for John Godber Centre please help** – Following a public meeting in November 2010, we are looking to gain grant funding for the following project at the John Godber Centre:
- To remove the dividing wall between Rooms 3 and 4 (downstairs) and replace by a soundproof concertina wall, so that this can become one room when necessary, but retaining the flexibility of still having two.
  - To soundproof the ceiling so that noise from bookings upstairs eg dancing or parties does not affect meetings in the rooms below
  - To replace the mismatch of flooring in the two rooms with unified flooring
  - To replace the single glazed window in one room by a double glazed unit, to tidy up electrics and decorate as necessary

**HOW YOU CAN HELP – We're not asking for money!**

We are aware that this project has much support from the community but we need to prove that support to enable us to get funding. If you feel able, could you write a letter of support for the project, either as an individual who uses/might use the Centre or as a member of a group which uses the Centre? Please also encourage friends in the community if they can help in this way.

We are currently turning away business because we cannot provide a medium sized room (the large hall upstairs is often too big for people but the rooms downstairs are too small).

The Centre is the Church's responsibility and gaining the grant funding will enable the Centre to move towards greater self-sufficiency and reduce potential drain on Church finances. So please help if you can.

Letters should be addressed to the Centre Manager (Mrs Kim Pears) or The Management Committee (Kathryn is Chair) and can be sent to the Centre or given to Kathryn. The deadline for this is 14<sup>th</sup> February. Many thanks in anticipation of your support.
